Healthy Corporate Cultures in Times of Crisis - main topic of the upcoming Enterprise for Health (EfH) Business Meeting

Which impact does the economic crisis have on our working life, and how can good mental health at work still be promoted? How do organisations make use of indicators for corporate health? These key points will be discussed by network members and experts at their Business Meeting on 25/26 May, hosted by Scania, Södertälje, Sweden. A number of member companies of the Enterprise for Health network formed a working group to find ways to broaden their survey instruments and include significant aspects of health, which is a step further towards improving health management in their own organisations and others. As a result, and based on scientific research and company experience, they suggested a pool of relevant items to be used in survey instruments, thereby giving the opportunity to provide an early health indicator, initiate processes of communication and improvement as well as allow further analyses and comparisons. The UK Health and Safety Executive (HSE) prepared a stress management competency indicator tool, which enables managers to assess whether effective stress management behaviours are part of their repertoire or not, and identify any gaps in skills or behaviours. The collaborative project PRIMA-EF has been focusing on the development of a European framework for psychosocial risk management with a special focus on work-related stress and workplace violence. The outputs are now fully available: An inventory of best practices, a guide for employers and worker representatives, specific user-friendly guidance sheets on key areas of the project in 6 languages, and a comprehensive book with a scientific background.
